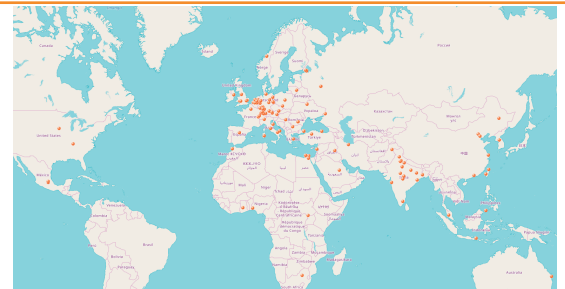


INTERNATIONALITY
